FLOATER CHA JOB DESCRIPTION

RVTD TRES DIAS

The main responsibility of the Floater Supply Cha is to fill in wherever needed in any of the service areas of the weekend.

In addition, the Floater Supply Chas are responsible for making sure that the bathrooms that the candidates are using are kept supplied with paper towels, toilet tissue, air fresheners, and anything else that is needed. You will also assist the Assistant Head Cha with the candles for the Saturday night serenade.

On Thursday: You will need to be at the camp entrance to direct traffic. Direct sponsors where to take their candidates luggage and where to drop their candidates. Be prepared to line the walks whenever the candidates move from one location to another. You may attend the reception and mingle with the candidates.

On Friday: Help out in areas as needed and directed by Assistant Head Cha. Also, be ready to help the palanca chas with putting out fanny palanca after "The Holy Spirit" Rollo.

On Saturday: Line the walks whenever the candidates are moving from place to place. Help out in areas as needed and directed by the Assistant Head Cha. Remember, tonight is the serenade. You will need to be at the entrance of the camp ground to direct the serenade traffic. It is your responsibility to keep them out of site. Remind the serenaders that they are to go to the designated area. Assist the Head and Assistant Chas to set up for the serenaders. Make sure that the candles and lighters are available and ready to distribute to the serenaders, as they line the walk to the chapel. The candles should be placed outside the kitchen door, after the entire team is in the kitchen.

On Sunday: Help out in areas as needed. Line the walk whenever candidates move from one place to another. Be available to the Assistant Head Cha with taking down any of the sections if needed. You also may be asked to help out with the cleaning of the dorms, as directed by the Assistant Head Cha. Again, you will be directing traffic, as people arrive for closing. They are to stay directly in front of the chapel, until the doors are opened for closing. Sponsors should be directed to pick up their candidates luggage.

<u>Reminder</u>: Please remember that the Assistant Head Cha needs to know where you are at all times. Your most important job on the weekend is to shadow the Assistant Head Cha and to be their feet and hands if needed.

In the event that there are vacancies in other departments at the start of the weekend, Floater Chas should be reassigned to fill those positions.
